It is the purpose of the Warrior Athletic Hall of Fame to recognize such individuals who have, through their performance, conduct, and achievement, brought credit and honor to themselves and the Woodhaven-Brownstown School District. Their public example will hopefully serve to inspire future graduates to perform and serve in the same spirit.

The Warrior Athletic Hall of Fame Committee invites annual nominations for candidates for the Warrior Athletic Hall of Fame. This award honors individuals whose deeds and character exemplify outstanding achievement in their life's work and/or service to their communities. The honoree's spirit and leadership are worthy of recognition and have inspired praise and gratitude among his or her peers. Nomination forms are available in the Athletic Office at WHS or online at <http://woodhaven.k12.mi.us/departments/athletics>. **Deadline for nominations for the 2018 class will be February 1st, 2018.** The Warrior Athletic Hall of Fame induction and banquet will be held **on March 11, 2018.**

Recommended requirements for nomination include:

- Recipient must have graduated from WHS at least 10 years ago, or have worked over 20 years for the Woodhaven Brownstown School District.
- The recipient has been recognized for a high level of achievement in his/her field and made significant contributions to that field at the local, state, national, and/or international levels.
- The individual has made a significant contribution to the WBSD and/or our community.
- The recipient has demonstrated leadership, character, and service in a variety of venues from his/her field of expertise to community, state, and national initiatives.
- Nominations for posthumous awards will be considered.
- Candidates will be nominated using the Hall of Fame nomination form.
- Candidates will be reviewed and selected by the Hall of Fame Selection Committee.
- There will be a limitation of 5 individuals per year. (Up to 10 will be accepted for the first year).
- Recipients will be recognized at the Hall of Fame banquet and a plaque will be displayed on the Hall of Fame wall located at Woodhaven High School.
